Building Preservation

Now that this year's great garage sale is over and Coupeville Lions are getting their well deserved rest, it is time to start looking forward to Ebey's Reserve/Coupeville Lions eighth annual Building Preservation Field School.

This year's school, restoring the Capt Thomas Coupe House at 504 Ninth Street in Coupeville, will be held the first two weeks of August. Unlike past years when the school was four weeks long, this year the school will be only two weeks, August 3-14, Monday thru Friday. Sessions are four hours in length, one in the morning and one in the afternoon. We will learn how to restore and practice restoration of windows and siding. This school is open to individuals with all levels of experience.

This is one of the oldest houses on Whidbey; built by the namesake for Coupeville in 1852. This project provides participants with a rare opportunity to get up close to and to study this historic structure on the shores of Penn Cove.

Sarah Steen, Preservation Coordinator at Ebey's Landing National Historic Reserve, will be reviewing the project at our meeting on July 22nd. A sign up sheet will be available at that time.
